

### Supplementary file 3: Main laws applicable in Finland and their goals

Forest Act (1096/1996, modified by 1085/2013)	Regulates forest use
Forest Information Act (419/2011)	Makes environmental forest information open
Nature Protection Act (9/2023)	Protect species, habitats, and biodiversity
Climate Act (423/2022)	Sets national climate goals
Metsähallitus Act (234/2016)	Defines the targets of Metsähallitus that governs state-owned forests
Finnish Constitution (731/1999)	Defines fundamental rights
Everyone's rights	Based on tradition, not written law
UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples	Non-binding declaration applies to the rights of the Sámi
